Surviving Not Thriving: The untold story of struggling Calgarians

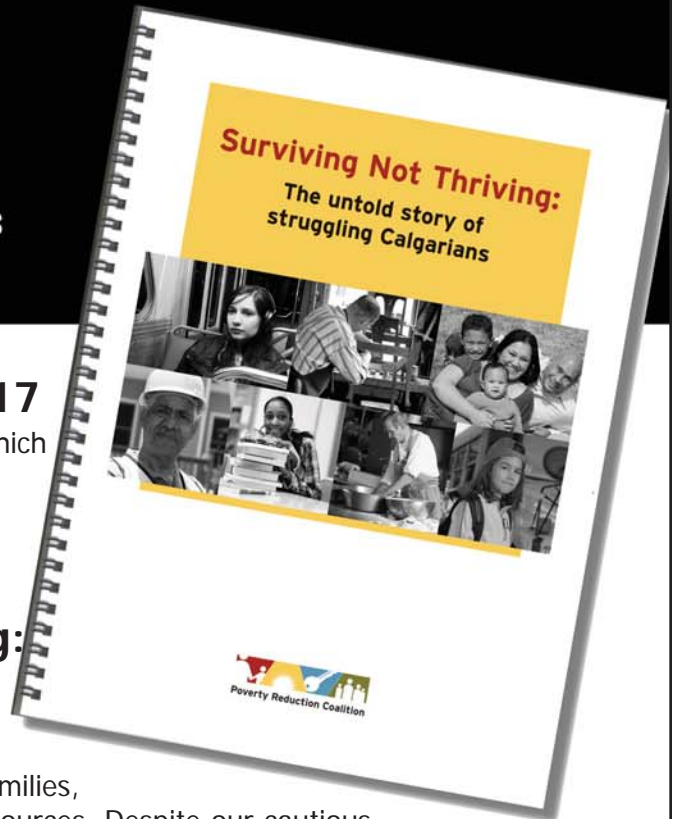
presents eight typical low-income families, each surviving on different income sources. Despite our cautious calculations, we found that half of the families in the report were falling further into debt each month, while the others were left with a monthly surplus ranging from **\$10 to \$127**.

The report forms the basis for the work being done by the Poverty Reduction Coalition. The Coalition believes that there is a role for everyone in identifying and implementing solutions to poverty in Calgary. We encourage you to join us as we share our findings and recommendations.
